
Hof University: Focused on our students



Our services for international students: Putting your needs first!


At Hof University, we put special effort into taking care of our international students. You can look forward to a warm welcome culture and plenty of services from our International Office, including:

Academic calendar

	Winter semester (1st semester)	Summer semester (2nd semester)
Application deadline for exchange students	May 31	October 31
Orientation weeks (mandatory)	last 2 weeks of September	first 2 weeks of March
Lecture/ exam period	October 1 - February 15	March 15 - July 31
Lecture-free period	February 16 - March 14	August 1 - September 30

Language Requirements

For attending lectures in **English** or **German**, you need at least **B2** according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Workload

According to the guidelines of the European Commission, 60 credits represent the workload of a full year of study; the workload for one semester corresponds to 30 credits.

Credits are awarded only when the module has been completed and all required examinations have been successfully taken. Exchange students can take as many modules as they wish but it is advisable to take no more than 30 – 35 credits.

Choosing your modules


Undergraduate students can choose their modules from any of our Bachelor's programs only. **Postgraduate students** can choose their modules from any of our Bachelor's and Master's programs.

However, all exchange students must fulfill the requirements set by their home institution.

Application process



Nomination by home institution

Every exchange student has to be officially nominated by the International Office of his/her home institution via e-mail to international@hof-university.de

Exchange students need to apply through our **online application system**.

Please note that our office cannot process the application without the required enclosures.

Required documents

The following documents are required for an exchange program at Hof University:

- Current academic transcript of records in English language (PDF)
- _ Passport photo in high resolution (JPG, 300x400)
- Copy of passport or ID Card (for EU citizens) (PDF)
- Letter of motivation (only double degree applicants)
- Short portfolio (only Textile Design applicants)

Application deadlines

Please make sure to apply before the end of our application period:


- For the following winter semester: May 31
- For the following **summer semester**: **October 31**

Admission letters are sent approximately one week after the application deadline.

Semester contribution

Studying as an exchange student at Hof University is free of charge. You only have to pay an **administrative fee** to the Student's Union of **approx. 100 €/semester** (subject to change). This fee allows e.g. for price reductions in the cafeteria and refectory and includes free public transportation in Hof and Münchberg.

Please enquire at your local German embassy regarding your visa requirements.

Meet and Greet service

During the arrival days, we offer a free-of-charge pick up service from the main train and bus station in Hof. Our student assistants will bring you directly to your accommodation.

Health insurance

The German government and the European Union have made it mandatory for all foreign students to have a <u>health insurance for the entire duration</u> of their studies.

Students from EU countries must present the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). It is essential that the insurance card is valid for the entire study period.

Students from Non-EU countries need to take out either a private health insurance that covers the entire study period or a German statutory health insurance.

For enrollment, it is mandatory to obtain a health insurance approved by a German statutory health insurance company.

Orientation period

We offer an Orientation period for all our international students before the start of each semester. During this period, the students will not only meet the other international students and get to know the university. We will also help with all administrative issues needed for studying in Hof (e.g. city registration, residence permit, enrollment, timetable, and so on).

Moreover, we provide intensive German language courses on different levels. Participation in our Orientation program will guarantee a relaxed start before the actual lectures begin.





How to apply for a room

After you have been nominated by your International Office, you start your online application via our online portal MoveOn. In this portal, you choose your favorite type of accommodation. Our Housing Office can help you to find an apartment only after you have been admitted officially to Hof University.

Exchange students from our partner institutions may either live

- in one of our student dormitories in a single room with a private bathroom or
- _ in a shared furnished flat in a single or a double room.

Accommodation costs approx. 270 - 450 € per month including energy and internet.

Please note: Rental contracts always run for a period of 6 or 12 months!

Winter semester: September 1 to February 28

Summer semester: March 1 to August 31





Living expenses

In comparison to other German cities, the living costs in Hof are rather moderate (especially regarding rent). In general, students should have approx. 700-800 € per month at their disposal for their cost of living.

If you require a visa, a financial proof of 861 EUR per month (= EUR 10,332 per year) is required by the Embassy.

Approximate cost calculation:

Rent:Compulsory health insurance:EUR 270 - 450 / monthEUR 110 / month

Food + personal expenditure: EUR 250 / month

Estimated total: about EUR 700 - 800 / month
