Quick facts

The **Summer School** *International Business Innovation* will take place from **July 05 until July 16, 2021**, and builds on IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems faculty's expertise.

For two weeks a group of **international bachelor students**, from IMC's international partner institutions, as well as regular **IMC students**, will jointly attend this intensive short program.

The participants will have the opportunity to learn how to

- Exploit opportunities for sustainable digital business innovation
- Design customer experiences and develop human-centered business innovations
- Lead corporate change in an effective & systemic manner
- Collaborate across cultures.

The program includes an **enrichment program** with the aim of offering both a high quality **academic and intercultural experience in Krems**.

We plan to offer the IMC Summer School on-site in Austria, on IMC's Campus Krems, if the COVID-19 situation allows. The program includes **social and cultural activities**, ranging from a city tour in Krems to a wine tavern visit (*Heuriger*), as well as social events. The aim is to give visiting students a taste of Austrian and European culture while providing opportunities for networking and socializing, all with the necessary health precautions.

Application requirements

Application requirements for the IMC Summer School are

- current enrollment in an undergraduate program in business studies at IMC Krems,
- **OR** official nomination for the program by IMC Krems partner university (if not IMC student)
- AND excellent English language skills

Nomination and application

Students should be nominated by the **nomination deadline on February 15, 2021**. Please note that the program has a limited number of spots. Therefore, nominations should be sent to IMC as soon as possible via e-mail.

After nomination, students will be asked to provide all necessary supporting documents (CV and letter of motivation). Details will be disclosed directly to the respective nominated person.

Program fee and services

Students do not pay a tuition fee for the program. However, we charge a participation fee to cover program services. To give students the flexibility of choice, applicants book the accommodation on their own.
